## Definitions

- a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.

- -time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- of graduates unavailable for employment.
- become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment.
